



## Acts of Kindness (A\*OK) Community Service @ The Conservatory School 2019 / 2020

Students in the middle grades at The Conservatory School will be required to provide 12 hours of community service each year; providing 'acts of kindness' for the school or local community.

These hours can be gathered at any time that is *beyond the students' academic day*, including during afterschool hours (if done in an aftercare program, the student must be forgoing an activity in order to provide service). Community service hours can also be gathered in the local community, a TCS classroom, at an after school event (e.g. Math Night), or in their place of worship.

For example:

- A 6th grade student could forgo an activity in aftercare in order to tutor a younger student in math.
- A 7th or 8th grade student could, with permission, go to Encore Aftercare to mentor a younger musician.

All community service must be performed under the supervision of an adult. The supervising adult, in addition to the administrative body of the community entity providing the assistance, must sign the A\*OK form.

It is recommended that students do their Acts of Kindness service for 3 hours each quarter, in order to complete their service before the end of the school year.
